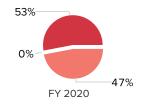

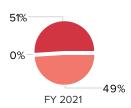

Months of operating cash -- unrestricted (Unrestricted Cash & Cash Equivalents/(Total Expense/12)) indicates the number of months an organization can operate at current average monthly expense levels with existing unrestricted cash and cash equivalents. This ratio is calculated using unrestricted numbers only.

Working capital -- unrestricted (Unrestricted Current Assets minus Unrestricted Current Liabilities) consists of the unrestricted resources available for operations. This calculation of working capital may differ from your internal calculations. Adequate working capital provides financial strength and flexibility to your organization, the ability to meet obligations as they come due, and the ability to take more risks, knowing there is a cushion to fall back on.

Current ratio unrestricted (Unrestricted Current Assets divided by Unrestricted Current Liabilities) determines the organization's ability to pay current debt using current assets. A ratio of 1.0 indicates that current assets are equal to current liabilities. A ratio of around 1.5 is a more comfortable position, allowing for more cushion against uncollected receivables or timing discrepancies between expected receipts and disbursements. Ideally this number should approach 2 which indicates ample short-term liquidity to obviate the need to borrow or sell assets.

Net assets as % of total expenses measures the net worth of an organization in relationship to its operating size. It is calculated as total net assets divided by total expenses. If the trend is level or increasing, then total net assets are keeping pace with growth in operating expenses.

Condition of fixed assets indicates the potential need for replacement or repair of fixed assets (such as buildings, furniture, office equipment, sets and props). This is especially significant for organizations that own a building or carry a long-term lease. Accumulated depreciation of less than 50% of the total value of fixed assets indicates a stock of relatively new assets. A high percentage (>80%) of accumulated depreciation could indicate aging infrastructure and need for funding the replacement or repair of fixed assets in the near future.

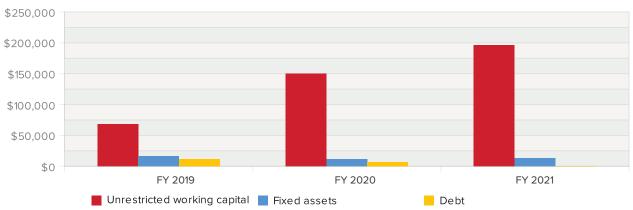
Leverage ratio (Total Debt divided by Total Unrestricted Assets) measures what proportion of your unrestricted assets are supported by debt. A number in excess of 50% may indicate liquidity problems, or reduced capacity for future borrowing.

Fixed assets net is the value of all land, buildings, equipment, leasehold improvements and other property and equipment owned by the organization. It is calculated net of accumulated depreciation to reflect the reduction in the value of an asset as it ages and is used.

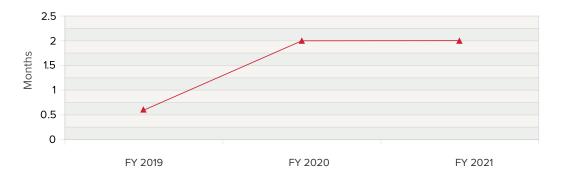
Total debt consists of all short and long-term contractual obligations of the organization, including lines of credit, loans, notes, bonds, and capital leases.

Debt service impact (Total Debt Service, including principal and interest, divided by Total Expense) calculates the % of an organization's total expenses applied to the total debt-service burden. The higher the percentage, the more the organization has to dedicate its resources to debt repayment rather than programming and other operating expenses.

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FY 2020 The majority of the education programming at the zoo was cancelled for the 2020 season (due to COVID-19). We we

able to reinstate our community engagement program FALCONERS (September 2020) and continue to offer incentive days (free) to the community throughout 2020.

With the closure and limited of schools, there were no outreach programs offered for the 2020 season. In 2020, the

zoo closed mid-March and reopened to the public mid-June.

FY 2021 Several of our educational programs and public events were reinstated in 2021 after taking a break in 2020 in

response to the pandemic. You will see an increase in program numbers and occurrences due to several of our programs and public events reinstated since 2020. Through conversations with school districts and teachers, we learned that field trips and outreach programs may be limited for their school due to budget availability, concerns toward the ongoing pandemic, limited capabilities with the current guidelines, and so on. With this knowledge, we anticipated smaller numbers than our regular season. Regardless, our top priority is the safety of our guests, staff, and animals as we continue to follow our safety protocols to ensure a safe and welcoming visit for each guest. Potter Park Zoo has long been a destination for families, school groups, and guests as a place where lasting memories are created. In 2021, one of our goals was to improve and provide an even more impactful visit through enhanced educational opportunities. Conservation-education stations are found throughout the zoo where the zoo's education volunteers interact with guests and engage them about the zoo's animals, conservation initiatives, and what 'you' can do locally to help.
