5. Financial Report YTD (preliminary) through June 30, 2023

**Revenue:** Year to date revenue at \$634,320.45 is over budget by \$25,822.45, with capital campaign revenue not included. Year to date revenue exceeds prior year by \$103,269.86 without the capital campaign.

**Expenses:** Year to date expenses at \$626,810.17 are \$84,978.17 over budget without the capital campaign. Overall expenses not including the capital campaign are 55 percent of the annual budget after six months (50 percent of the year). **Net surplus:** The net surplus from operations not including capital campaign is \$17,510.28.

**Cash:** The days of cash decreased from 377 days April 30, 2023 to 271 days as of June 30, 2023 with capital campaign cash and expenses not included.

  - a. Approval of repayment for veterinary facility costs incurred by Ingham County and the Ingham County Building Authority
    - 1 Gabe Rodriguez-Garriga made the following motion: Any and all costs incurred by Ingham County and the Ingham County Building Authority in regard to constructing, equipping and financing the new animal health facility required by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums to replace the existing veterinary facility not to exceed a total project cost of \$6 million will be reimbursed by the Potter Park Zoological Society. George Berghorn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
  - b. Approval of Michigan Arts and Culture Council grant application for capital improvements and operational support
    - Roxanne Truhn made the following motion: The Potter Park Zoological Society Board approves the Michigan Arts and Culture Council grant applications for both capital improvements and operational support. Gabe Rodriguez-Garriga seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
