#### **General Items**

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 11:42 a.m.

#### **Board Items**

Financial Report YTD (preliminary) through July 31, 2025

#### Revenue

- 1. Revenue year-to-date not including capital campaign is under budget in program revenue (-\$11,372), contributions (-\$12,392), member fees (-\$14,680), and revenue-other (-\$3,150). Overall revenue not including capital campaign is under budget by \$41,596.
  - a. Program revenue is under budget mainly due to the Eaton RESA revenue budgeted to be recognized through June, but actual revenue was recognized through May. This totaled \$10,600. Additional Eaton RESA revenue will be recognized later in the year starting in September at an increased rate due to a new contract. This line item should end the year over budget.

b. Contributions are under budget primarily due to several grants that were budgeted but have not yet been received. This should hit budget by the end of the year.

- c. Member fees are under budget and currently have \$156,190 in deferred revenue to be recognized over the remainder of the year.
- d. Revenue- other is under budget due to a payment made for the penny presser revenue share budgeted for later in the year and cash back rewards that have not been redeemed yet this year.
- 2. Year-to-date revenue without the capital campaign is 41% of the annual budget after 7 months or 58% of the year.

## Expense

- 1. Total expenses are \$393,778 over budget year-to-date with capital campaign <u>not</u> included. Without the \$416,000 bond payment included expenses are \$22,222 under budget.
  - a. Salary and wages are under budget by \$34,860. This is due to the payroll accrual in December for a portion of the first payroll in January.
  - b. Payroll benefits are over budget by \$4,088 due to an added benefit package for a new employee. Additionally, we are changing health care providers so this is likely to be over budget for the remainder of the year.
  - c. Potter Park Zoo Support includes the \$416,000 payment for the bond and is over budget by \$382,670. Removing the bond payment, Potter Park Zoo support is under budget \$33,330.
  - d. Conferences, conventions, and meetings is under budget by \$7,086. This difference will continue to shrink as expenses are incurred for the AZA conference coming up.
  - e. Other expenses is over budget by \$8,073 due to the reimbursement of the staff's overpayment of the healthcare co-pay.
  - f. Professional fees are over budget \$18,207 partially due to audit fees incurred \$2,500 over budget, accounting services \$8,038 over budget, and cleaning services \$3,097 over budget.
- 2. Total expenses, <u>not</u> including capital campaign or the bond payment, are 55% of the annual budget after 7 months or 58% of the year.

### Net surplus/deficit:

1. The net deficit from operations not including the capital campaign and including the bond payment is \$624,385 which is over budget by \$435,374. Without the bond payment the net deficit is \$208,385. The net deficit is budgeted at \$189,010 as of July 31, 2025.



Cash: Days of cash are at 26 with the capital campaign not included.
